## ~ ALES ~

Ales are a type of beer brewed from malted barley using a top-fermenting brewers' yeast. This yeast ferments the beer quickly, leaving it sweet, full-bodied and fruity.

**Ale** - *Generally smooth, less hop bite & gas than US styles. Nitro refers to non-CO2 Beers that use Nitrogen as an accelerant & finish creamy*

## ~ OTHER ALES ~

Now all the other ales come into play, from the Wheat / Weiss / Witt styles to the rich and hearty Porters & Stouts. The key factor in their tastes is that each are brewed with Ale yeasts - top fermenting, warm activated, strains of cultured yeasts. The variance in the colors of your beers is the result of the roasting of the barley malts before they are boiled. The richer the roast the darker the brew!

**Porters & Stouts** - *The name "stout" for a dark beer came from strong porter, may also be called "Extra Porter", "Double Porter" or "Stout Porter"*
